**REV!VE USVI AND ST. CROIX FOUNDATION STEWARD DONATION
OF MORE THAN 18,000 POUNDS OF MEDICAL SUPPLIES FOR THE
TERRITORY'S HOSPITALS**

St. Croix, U.S.V.I. -- St. Croix Foundation for Community Development and ReV!ve USVI, one of the Foundation's sponsored partners, stewarded a large donation of medical supplies for Governor Juan F. Luis Hospital and Medical Center (JFL) on St. Croix and Roy Lester Schneider Hospital on St. Thomas. The medical supplies, which include a wide variety of items necessary for patient care, were secured by Elan Insurance Group and shipped by ReV!ve USVI and St. Croix Foundation. The 18,463 pounds of donated medical supplies include items ranging from examination gloves and tracheal tubes to resuscitation kits and oxygen regulators.

"We are extremely grateful for the outpouring of support we have received in light of the passage of Hurricane Maria, and this donation of medical supplies will go a long way in assisting

us to continue to provide quality healthcare for our patients and the community as a whole," said Wanda Ruben, RN, MSN, Chief Executive Officer of JFL.

Representatives from the St Croix Foundation and Omar Haedo of Elan Insurance Group will present the medical supplies to JFL personnel On Tuesday, October 31, 2017 at 11:30am in front of the hospital, 4007 Estate Diamond Ruby, Christiansted.

A portion of the medical supplies will then be transported by Omar Haedo, CEO of Elan Insurance Group, to St. Thomas and distributed to the Roy Lester Schneider Hospital on Wednesday.

"As the Foundation strives to support our community's recovery, we are identifying the most effective, high-impact strategies to ensure the well-being of our residents," said Deanna James, Executive Director of the St. Croix Foundation. "As our only hospital, JFL is crucial to the overall health of our island community and the Foundation is happy to do our part to facilitate this donation."
